

Kites and Categories

Objective: Students will place items into their appropriate categories.

Materials: • Tape

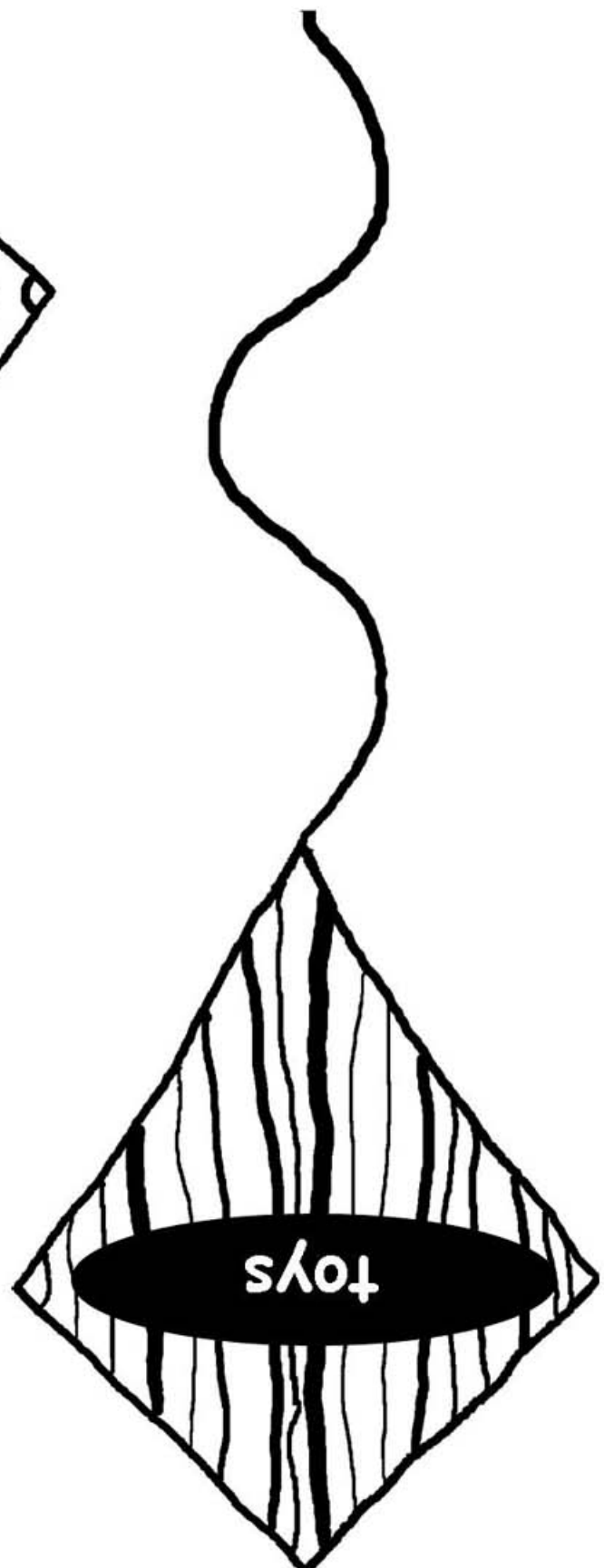
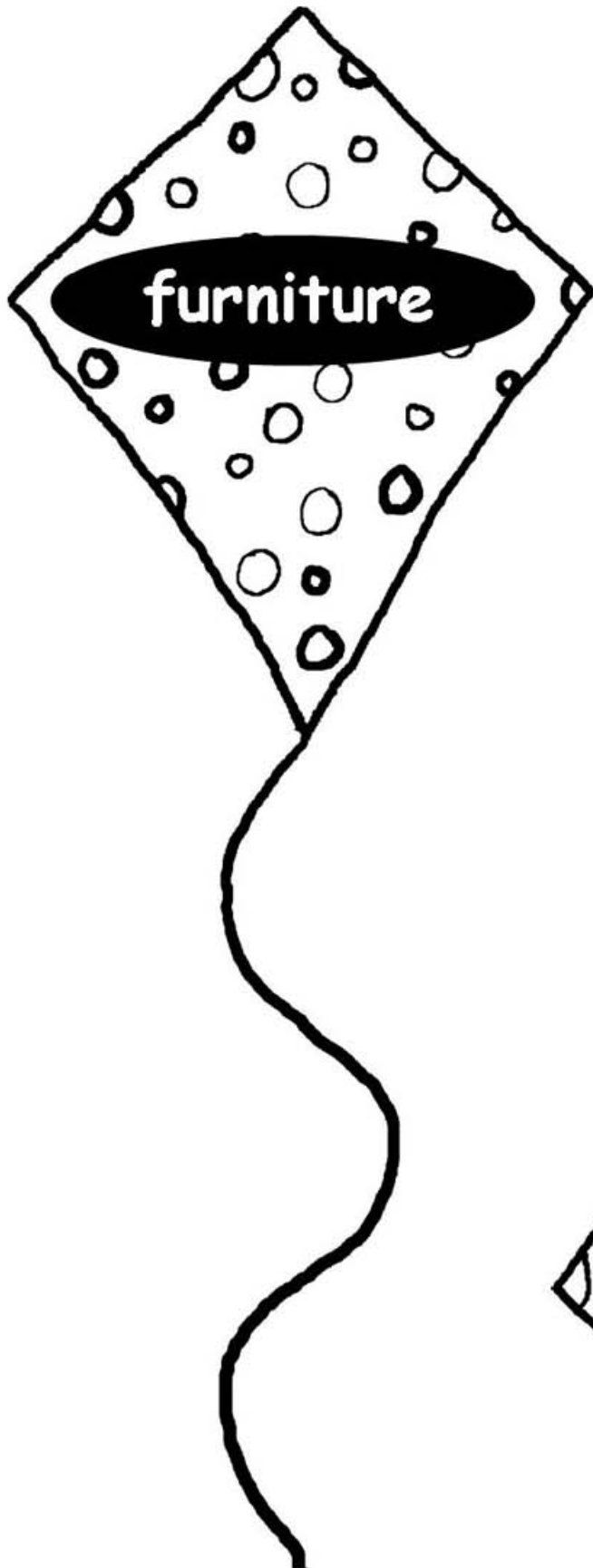
To Make:

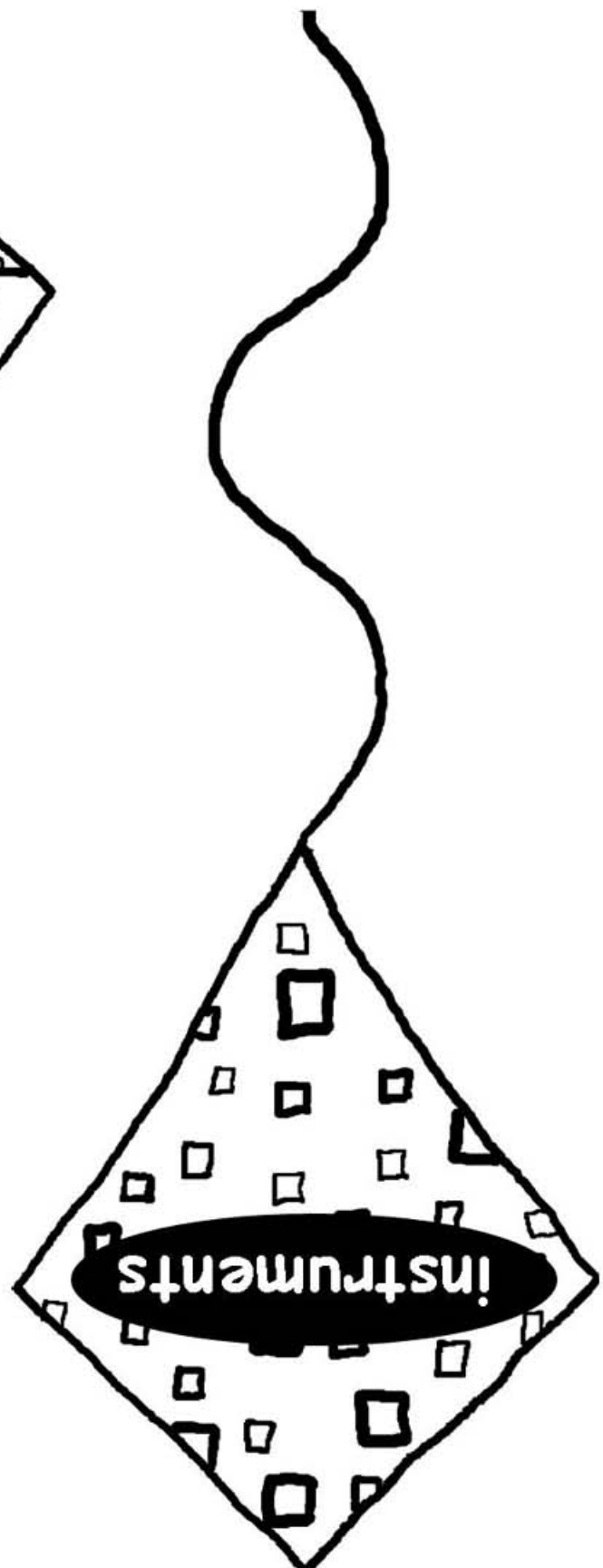
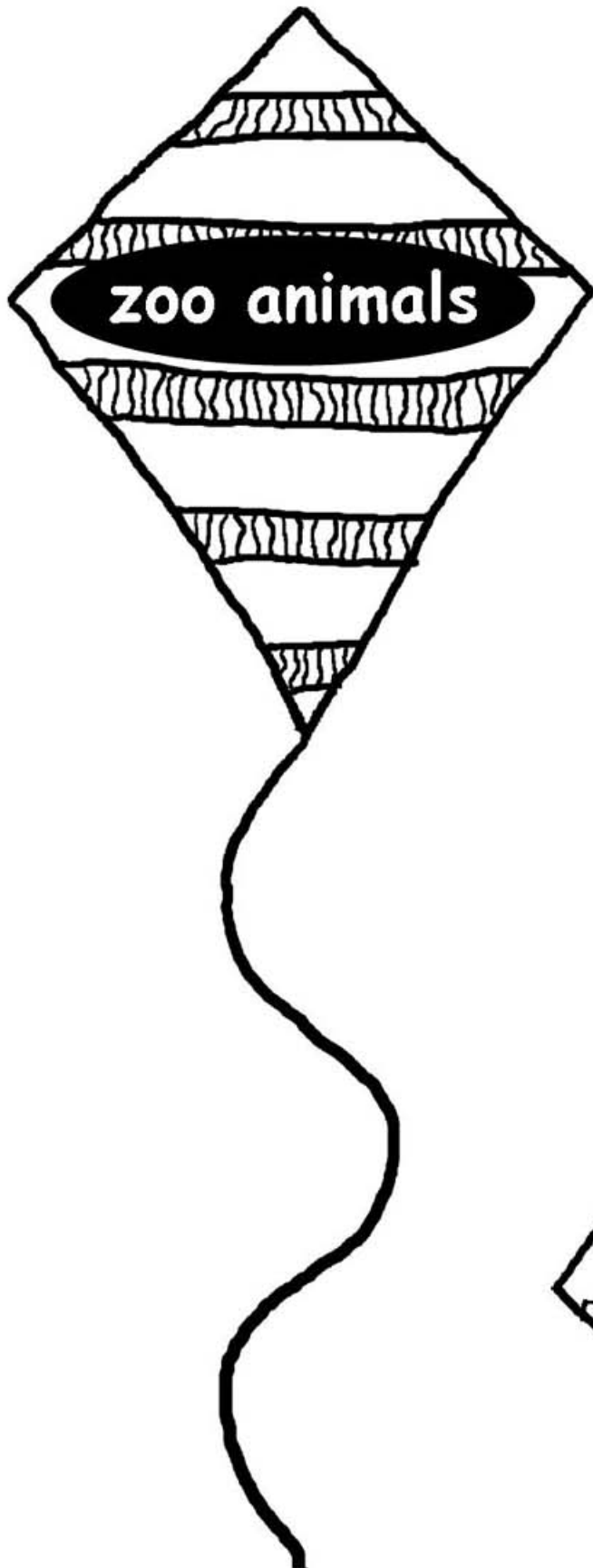
(Everything can be printed on card stock paper and laminated to add to durability or printed on regular paper for quick use.)

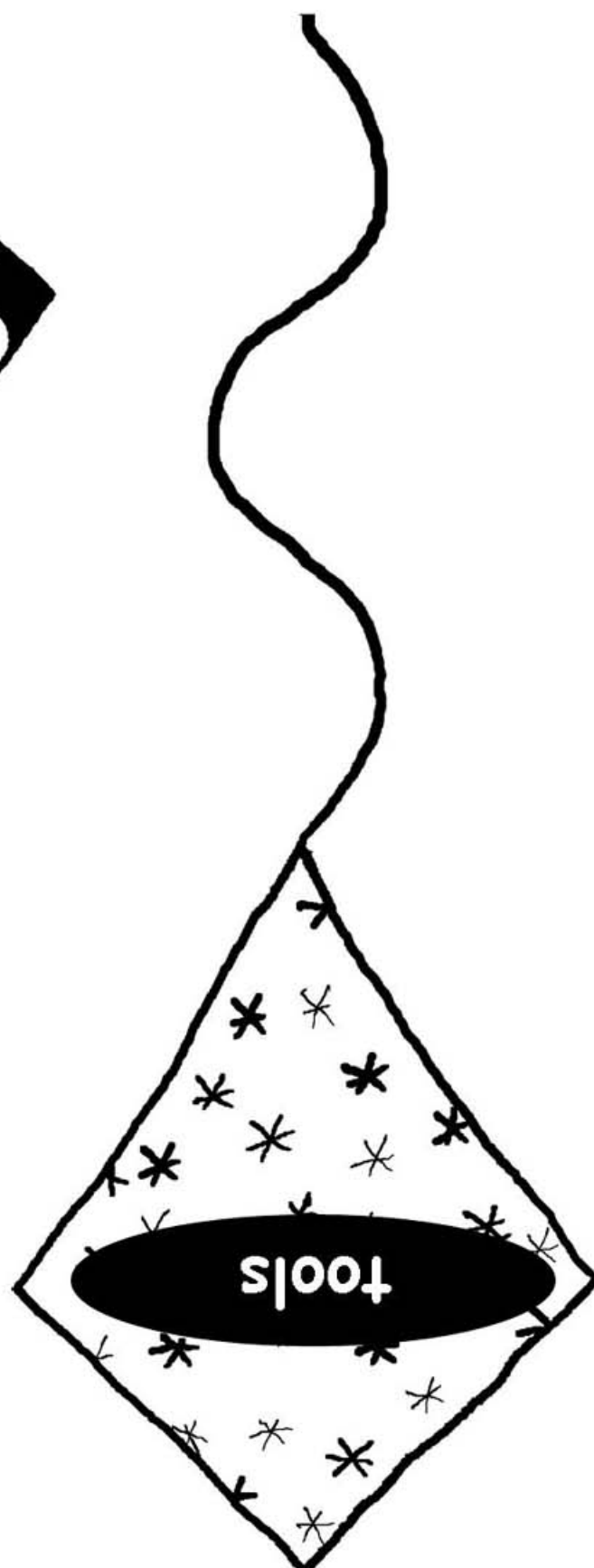
1. Print out entire "Kites and Categories" activity.
2. Cut out kites and tape them to the wall.
3. Cut out kite tails and place them face down on the table.
4. Have extra tape available to place on the kite tails as the game is played.

To Play:

1. Introduce the category titles on each kite.
2. Have one student pick a kite tail from the table and read the word (or you may read it for him/her). Next, the student should decide which category the item belongs to.
3. Then, the student should tape the kite tail to the kite string of the appropriate category.
4. The activity is over once all the kite tails have been used.
