

## Spin and Describe

**Objective:** Students will describe specific objects by naming such things as attributes, location, function, etc.

**Materials:** • Brads

### To Make:

*(Everything can be printed on card stock paper and laminated to add to durability or printed on regular paper for quick use.)*

1. Print entire "Spin and Describe" activity.
2. Cut out each spinner and arrow along the dotted lines.
3. Assemble each spinner by connecting the arrow to the circle with a brad.
4. If you have more than five students playing at the same time, you may group them into teams or print more spinners to accommodate all students. Printing more just means that some students will be using the same game spinner.

### To Play:

1. Give each student a spinner.
2. Have one student spin their spinner and describe the word/picture the arrow landed on. You may assist your students by prompting them with questions such as, "Where would you find it?, What does it look like?, What does it smell like?, What does it feel like?, What does it sound like?, What does it taste like?, or What do you do with it?".
3. Continue playing by allowing the students to take turns spinning and describing the words/pictures they land on.
4. The activity is over once all the students have had the opportunity to describe all eight words/pictures on their spinner.
