Preparation of the Speech Tote

Materials:

- 9" x 12" Sheet of tag board for "tote" template
- 2 pieces of 9" x 12" paper stock. Some choices are:
Construction paper, white sulphite drawing paper, tag board
- 18" x 18" Paper cutter
- Scissors
- Hole punch
- Assorted watercolor markers
- Assorted watercolor paints
- Crayons
- Colored pencils
- White school glue
- Laminating machine or clear contact film

Directions:


1. Photocopy page 296.
2. Glue the black line copy on the 9" x 12" tag board.
3. Cut and trim the tote to use as a template.
4. Select two pieces of the desired 9" x 12" paper stock for the tote front and back.
5. Place template on top of each paper piece and trace the outside and inside borders. Make sure that the template is correctly aligned to the left and bottom edges of the paper.
6. Cut off the vertical excess strip remaining on the right side of each paper. Note: trimming on the top edge of the tote and the opening inside of the handle will be done at a later time.
7. Select one surface on each traced and trimmed page as an outside face (front and back) and decorate the surfaces as desired (child's name, decorative theme, pictures, etc.).
8. After decoration is complete, place the two papers together with the decorative sides facing outward and the clean sides facing toward each other. Making sure that the edges are aligned, run the two sheets together through a laminating machine. Position the "paper sandwich" so that the film seals over both surfaces and leaves a liberal border (1" to 1 1/2") around the entire tote.
9. Using scissors or a paper cutter, carefully trim the four edges of the sealed tote leaving 1/4" - 3/8" film border around the entire tote.
10. Using scissors, cut along top outline of the tote forming the handle and opening the tote envelope.
11. Using a hole punch or the tips of a sharp pair of scissors, punch several pilot holes in the handle opening area of the tote. Insert scissors into the opening and cut out the remaining rectangular areas to form the finger space of the handle.


Helpful Hints:


1. The paper stock for the tote may be cut in advance to match the outermost dimensions of the finished tote. This can be done with a paper cutter and facilitates preparation of totes for a larger number of students.
2. The tote template may be enlarged to more closely fit a standard piece of paper (8 1/2" x 11" or larger). This can be accomplished by experimenting with the enlarging percentages (above 100%) on the copy machine and adjusting them to the desired finished size and available paper stock.
3. The tote front and back covers may be glued to form the tote envelope. A thin line of glue can be run just inside (1/4" - 3/8") of the left, bottom and right edges with the two papers then placed together and allowed to dry. Once dry, the top and handle may be completed.
4. If a laminating machine is not available, clear contact film can be used to cover the tote. It may be placed over a glued or non-glued tote.


